A late Victorian mahogany four glass mantel timepiece with brass single fusee movement, the backplate detailed 'J.W Benson London 9258', the silvered rectangular dial with black Roman numerals and inscribed 'J.W Benson, London', within an engraved foliate surround, the rectangular case with bevelled glass panels, on a stepped rectangular base and bracket feet, height 29cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

1160. Overall good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface wear and scratches but nothing significant. All glass panels appear to be in good condition with only signs of minor glue residue where they have been secured. Pendulum is present and certainly looks original.

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
