### LOT 4128

A pair of Watcombe terracotta pottery vases, designed by Christopher Dresser, late 19th century, the brown glazed spherical bodies decorated with a black ground foliate band heightened with white beading, black printed and painted marks to bases, height 12cm (chips to feet), together with a pair of Watcombe floral decorated vases, height 14.5cm (faults).

### Condition Report

4128. 1st spherical vase - crazed. Surface scratches to glaze of widest part of body. Approx 1cm square chip to exterior edge of foot opposite a pinhead sized manufacturing blemish.

2nd spherical vase - crazed. Surface scratches to glaze of widest part of body. Approx 1.5cm x 0.5cm side chip to exterior edge of foot.

1st vase - circumference of foot extensively chipped. Approx 1cm square chip to exterior edge of neck rim with tiny nick alongside. Scratches to glazed surface.

2nd vase - approx 1/4 section of footrim chipped. Approx 2/3 section of neck rim missing due to large chip.

Small chip to side edge of one handle. Scratches to glazed surface.
