A mid-19th century yew, elm and ash Windsor armchair with a pierced splat back, the solid seat raised on turned legs united by a crinoline stretcher, height 90cm, width 54cm.

Condition Report

2002. One of the spindles has been shaved away to one side. The seat has some old woodworm and two cracks. One rear leg has a vertical crack running through and there are some small cracks to the stretchers.
