Condition Report

2014. The chair is in an overall well restored state of condition, with some general repairs throughout. The seat panel has had a repaired crack and has a support bar fixed to the bottom of the seat, also inserted repairs around the arm support joints. Some areas of coloured filler on some of the back and supports. Also some professional repairs to the stretcher joints and an overall well waxed surface.
