'Tudric' pewter rose bowl, designed by Archibald Knox, model number '0229', the body cast in relief with a band of scrolling tendrils and honesty seedpods, the two handles continuing down to form arched supports, bearing registration and model number to underside, height 15cm, width 29cm.
