A Lucie Rie studio pottery stoneware bottle vase with flared undulating rim and ovalled neck, covered in a volcanic glaze with copper red details against a blue/grey ground, seal mark to base, height 26cm (minor restoration to rim). Provenance: the current owner was a student of Lucie Rie and Hans Coper at the Camberwell School of Art.

Condition Report

4140. There is a tiny hairline crack to the glaze coming from a small glazing fault on the rim. Also another tiny glazing crack running between two bubbles on the underside of the rim. One very small point of barely visible restoration to rim. Otherwise in good condition.
