## LOT 4030

A set of eight late 19th/early 20th century Gothic Revival oak panel back side chairs, the chamfered slender backs carved with three different designs of gothic tracery and rosettes above solid seats, on chamfered block legs united by stretchers, height 107cm, width 45cm.

## Condition Report

4030. There are three each of the slightly different tracery backs and two with the stylized flower, otherwise the chairs are the same. All but one of the chairs have gaps in the seat panels where the separate parts have come away. Two of the chairs have some areas of woodworm to rear legs, seats and lower back. Most of the seats have had some later nails put through the seat panels to hold them firmly to the seat rails. Five of the chairs are quite wobbly and have quite loose joints. Seat height 44.4cm.
