A 9ct gold keyless wind hunting cased pocket watch with an unsigned jewelled lever movement, the enamelled dial with Roman numerals, the case front interior detailed '9ct', case diameter 4.7cm, a gold cased keywind open-faced lady's fob watch, detailed within the case back 'K18', with a key, and a silver keyless wind half-hunting cased gentleman's pocket watch, the movement detailed 'Lancashire Watch Co Ltd Monitor, 889043', Birmingham 1909, with a base metal watch chain.

### Condition Report

996. 9ct pocket watch - case is worn and typical scratches, back of case very thin, dented and damaged. No inscription. Dial looks ok, but has a few very faint hairlines which are noticeable under magnification. Inner case is gilt metal. It winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case diameter 4.7cm. Gross weight 77g.

18ct lady's fob watch - case is a little thin with typical wear and scratches. Back of case gapes slightly when closed, but no significant damage or dents. Inner case is gilt metal. Dial is a bit dirty with minor scratches/marks. It winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case diameter 3.8cm. Gross weight 34.4g.

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
