An early 20th century oak breakfront bookcase cabinet, the arched frieze back panel above a dentil moulded pediment and four glazed doors, flanked by finely carved Corinthian columns, the base fitted with three drawers above panelled cupboard doors, raised on a plinth base, height 243cm, width 219cm, depth 57cm.

Condition Report

2009. Overall condition is good with some overall typical surface scuffs, marks and bumps. A few minor scrapes and a few small chips and bumps to corners and edges. The finely carved capitals have a few tiny little chips to edges, and there is a corner missing to the bottom of one column. All locks and handles are present, but the lower middle door has a loose lock plate that needs securing.

Depth of interior shelves on top 31cm and 26cm. Depth of interior shelves in base 49cm and 42cm.
