A pair of French porcelain figures, late 19th century, modelled as a man and woman each carrying a basket of flowers, he with a squirrel on his shoulder, she with a bird, underglaze blue and impressed marks to bases, height 23cm, together with two other pairs of Continental porcelain figures (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1461. Boy with squirrel - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Girl with bird - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Boy and girl with floral garlands - both with chip to hat brim, boy also missing left little finger. Otherwise, both with typical minor losses to floral garlands and wear to gilding.

Standing muse - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Seated muse - chip to headdress and footrim of base which is hardly noticeable when on a flat surface.

Otherwise ok.
