## Condition Report

1445. Typical fine crazing to glaze. Vertical haircrack through crown and dates which has some restoration and repainting. Two similarly restored slightly curved rim haircracks to right of handle, one by Victoria's shoulder and other nearer handle through thistle decoration. One much shorter to left side of handle with similar restoration. Small patch of filling to one moulded part of handle.
