A Minton's majolica two-handled game pie dish, cover and liner, circa 1874, the cover moulded with fallen birds and a rabbit above basketweave sides, impressed marks to base, length 31cm (cover handle repaired, liner cracked).

Condition Report

1420. Typical fine crazing to glaze overall.

Cover - 3 riveted repairs to handle, minor restoration to tips of 3 wings and tiny glaze frits to one beak and one acorn.

Liner - heavily crazed, cracked and stained.

Dish - tiny chip to rim, but otherwise ok.
