LOT 1410

A Royal Worcester porcelain part dessert service, circa 1912-16, each piece painted with a still life of fruit within a pink and foliate gilt panelled border against a cobalt blue ground, comprising a tazza, signed F. Roberts, and five plates, signed R. Sebright, printed marks to bases, plate diameter 22.4cm (some faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1410. Tazza - foot detached and visibly glued with crazing. Plate top badly cracked from rim to fruit panel and held together with tape to underside.

1st plate - minor hairline to rim underside approx 2.5cm long, just visible to surface at 11 o'clock. Area of scratches to pink ground of one panel at 8 o'clock.

2nd plate - heavily crazed with bad haircrack running from rim, into and around edge of fruit panel.

3rd plate - badly cracked with numerous haircracks. Some crazing.

4th plate - badly cracked through panel in at least two areas and crazed.

5th plate - heavily crazed.
