A Chinese silk embroidered and pleated apron skirt, late Qing dynasty, the red ground with blue vertical stripes, worked in coloured and gilt threads with precious objects and scrolls, the cream ground borders similarly worked with figural and landscape vignettes, with bat and ruyi head framing, length 95cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1223. Fundamentally in reasonably good order. The green lining has staining and spotting and the waistband is stained. The red ground has some minor pulled threads and some random hand sewn red threads mostly holding the pleats in place. Some of the applique is lifting slightly and subsequently has minor losses.

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
