A pair of George III silver sauce boats, each with a reeded scroll handle and beaded rim above a half-reeded body, on an oval domed and beaded foot, London 1817, maker's mark rubbed, length 22cm.

Condition Report

320. First Sauce Boat - small split by upper handle terminal mainly visible to interior, hallmarks heavily rubbed.
Second Sauce Boat - small dent to one side above reeding, hallmarks rubbed. Minor dent to top of foot.
Hallmarks are on the exterior just below the spout/pouring lip.
Weight of both Sauce Boats together is 1103g.
