A Victorian gold carbuncle garnet and rose cut diamond brooch of shaped oval form, the central oval carbuncle garnet mounted with a star set rose cut diamond within a beaded surround, the back glazed with a locket compartment, traces of registration lozenge to back, width 3.8cm.

Condition Report

738. The rose diamond is of a rather grey appearance and looks to be raised from its settings on one side. The carbuncle garnet is in good condition. The brooch setting is also in good condition, apart from a small split to the bottom edge at the back. The registration stamp is missing its top and bottom points. The brooch is rather heavily tarnished and would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Weight 7.4g.

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
