A gold, garnet and topaz set pendant of lozenge shaped form, mounted with the principal cushion shaped garnet within a surround of four cushion shaped topaz and an outer surround of twenty cushion shaped topaz with four cushion shaped garnets to each point, length 4.7cm (previously mounted with a brooch fitting), on a 9ct gold faceted curb link neckchain with a sprung hook shaped clasp, length 38.5cm, a gold, garnet and topaz set pendant of lozenge shaped form, length 3.6cm (previously mounted as an earring), fitted to a gold multiple link neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '9ct', length 41cm, and a pair of gold and red gem set single stone earstuds.

Condition Report

742. Pendant - note that the pendant has been converted from a Victorian brooch. The pendant loop has been fitted to the original hinge that would have accommodated the brooch pin, the brooch hook shaped clasp has been filled away. There is a small drilled hole near to one garnet, which probably took a safety chain when originally worn as a brooch. The piece is in otherwise good condition, with original blooming to the gold. The neckchain has a modern import mark to the clasp. Smaller pendant ♦ it is lacking its original earring top fitting but otherwise in good condition, with original blooming to the gold. The more modern multiple link neckchain is showing signs of wear in places.

742. Pendant ♦ weight 13.7g.

Chain ♦ weight 9g.

Pendant & chain ♦ weight 6.8g.

Earrings ♦ weight 0.5g.
