A collection of Chinese export porcelain, Kangxi and Qianlong period, including three blue and white mugs, height 6.7cm, a blue and white ovoid teapot and cover, painted with figures, height 18.5cm, a famille rose enamelled blue and white baluster vase, height 19.5cm, a famille rose tankard, height 13cm (restored), and a small group of mostly blue and white teaware (some faults).

Condition Report

1041. 3 x Kangxi Mugs - 1 with star crack to base and crack to handle, 2 with minor rim chips and one with chip to handle.

Teapot - Good condition. No chips, cracks and repairs.

Vase - Small chip to footrim, otherwise good condition.

Mug - Restored and overpainted.

3 x Teabowls - Good condition.

2 x Teabowls - 1 chipped and cracked, 1 x repaired.

Slop bowl - Cracked.

4 x Famille Rose Saucers - One chipped, two cracked, one repaired.

2 x Blue and White saucers - Good condition
