### LOT 1109

A Japanese silk embroidered kimono, Taisho/Showa period, worked in coloured and gilt threads with flowers and pine above a waterfall with leaping carp below, on a mushroom ground, length 140cm (some faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

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### Condition Report

1109. Generally fairly good condition but there is some damage. There is some un-threading of the gilt thread and coloured thread in places. The leaping carp on the front panel has come away from the twin gauze-like silk and there are some other places where the gilt fish was torn away slightly from the thin backing. Creases to silk and some slight staining. Colours are very good and vibrant.

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
