A Vienna porcelain cabaret set, early 19th century, glazed in purple lustre, gilt overlaid with foliate scrollwork above bands of bellflower and laurel leaves, comprising coffee pot and cover, hot water pot and cover, sugar bowl and cover, two coffee cans and saucers and an octagonal tray with pierced trellis rim, underglaze blue shield marks to bases with some impressed numerals, 'D. Soloman, Esq.' collection label to base of tray, length of tray 38cm (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1475. Overall enamelling and gilding in great condition with very minimal wear.

Tray - large section of one corner visibly broken away and riveted back with associated break and rivet repair of pierced gallery at one end with some minor filling.

Two saucers - minute nick to one underside rim edge, otherwise in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Two cups - one badly cracked and chipped, other with two small chips to rim and one associated short crack.

Sugar and cover - restored and filled chip to edge of cover approx 3.5cm x 1.5cm and two other smaller chips.

Large pot and cover - extensive chipping to edge of cover, tip of spout chipped.

Small pot and cover - cover broken in half and visibly repaired with considerable losses and chips.
