Ten Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester porcelain soup plates, circa 1820, each painted with a central single pink rose on a budding leafy stem within gilt scrollwork and apple green ground rims, edged with gilded gadrooned moulding, impressed marks to bases, diameter 26.3cm. Note: a similar sauce tureen is illustrated in Henry Sandon's 'Flight and Barr Worcester Porcelain 1783-1840', page 148, plate 136.

Condition Report

1421. Generally good condition. Two plates have minor chips to underside of rim, otherwise in good condition. One plate has a bad visible scratch to green border, otherwise in good condition. The other seven plates are in good order with only typical light surface wear and scratches and minor wear to gilt.
