A Derby porcelain Kakiemon cup and saucer, early 19th century, painted with flowering branches, heightened in gilt, red painted mark to base, diameter of saucer 15.2cm, together with a small group of decorative ceramics, including a majolica shell shaped dish, a majolica two-handled bowl and two jugs (minor faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1429. Majolica shell dish - 4cm hairline to rim and chip to footrim.

Quimper jug - repaired chip to rim.

Copeland jug - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Green basket - one handle restored, otherwise ok.

Derby cup and saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Wear to gilt rim on saucer.
