A John Rose Coalport porcelain part service, circa 1820-25, decorated with panels of floral sprays within gilt scroll borders against a cobalt blue ground, comprising teapot and cover, milk jug, slop bowl, six cups and four saucers, two plates and a pot and cover, together with four saucetureen covers, two with lion finials (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1444. Overall crazing to the majority and some light staining, some gilding losses to rim edges particularly.
One plate - heavily stained.
One large cup, one smaller cup and two saucers cracked.
Otherwise other pieces in good order, no chips, cracks or repairs.
One lion finial tureen lid cracked, others ok.
