A small group of English porcelain teawares, mid-18th century and later, including a Worcester The Argument pattern saucer, diameter 12cm, a Worcester The Cannonball pattern tea bowl, a Derby pale blue ground saucer, painted with floral panels, and a Japan pattern cup and saucer (some faults).

### Condition Report

1471. Worcester Cannonball tea bowl - cracked.

Two Worcester saucers - both badly cracked, one repaired (heightened in gilt).

Purple/gilt floral tea bowl - restoration to rim.

Larger pink/brown floral tea bowl - cracked and heavily crazed and stained.

Cup with cobalt blue/gilt border - cracked, heavy losses to gilding on interior.

Japan pattern cup and saucer - heavily scratched to interiors.

Similar Japan pattern cup - cracked and repaired.

Derby saucer - crazed.

Pale blue cup and saucer - minor staining and gilding losses.

Other pieces in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
