A collection of decorative ceramics, mid-19th century and later, including a Jean Gille of Paris pedestal base, modelled as three fauns playing musical instruments, a pair of Noritake vases, decorated with riverside landscapes, and a pair of figures, modelled in 18th century dress (some faults).

Estimate: £30 - £50

Condition Report

1430. Jean Gille stand - height 19.5cm. Restoration to the legs of two of the fauns. Minor losses to the instruments and gilding.

Noritake vases - one has restoration to the rim and neck.

Perfume bottle stopper - faint hairline to neck.

Teapot - restoration to one corner, chip to spout.

Figure group on circular base - restoration to arm and foot.

Vienna style vase and stand - loose on stand, probably missing lid, gilding rubbed.

Chinese table lamp base - repaired wooden base.

Figure with peacock - repaired arm.

Seated figure - restoration to leg.

Conta Boehme figure - missing portion from tree trunk.

Girl and boy figures - minor chips to flowers, otherwise ok.
