## LOT 1150

An early Victorian figured mahogany regulator longcase clock, the brass eight day four pillar movement with deadbeat escapement and maintaining power, the 12½ inch silvered brass circular dial with outer Arabic minutes framing subsidiary seconds and hours, inscribed 'J. Nelson London', the arched hood with moulded pediment above a circular glazed door and cut corners, the trunk with cut corners and glazed arch door, on a panelled base and plinth, height 202.8cm, with mercury pendulum, brass weight, case keys and winding key.

## Condition Report

1150. A good quality English regulator in original condition and in working order. Good quality mechanism complete but requires a full service due to its dirty condition, all mechanical parts are original and nothing is missing.

Dial and bezel ring require re-silvering, hands all original.

Mahogany case is in sound condition, the only small fault found being minor scratches around trunk door lock.

Winding key not original.

A very nice clock.
