### LOT 1185

An early 19th century figured mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the circular painted dial with Roman numerals, subsidiary seconds and inscribed 'Law & Son, Balls Pond Rd', the hood with arched surmount, the trunk with arched door flanked by fluted cut corners, on a panelled base and bracket feet, height 219cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £200 - £400

### Condition Report

1185. Mechanism complete but would require some attention to return to full working order. Pendulum complete and ok. Dial rather crudely over-painted and will require redoing. Some chips and scratches to dial surface. Trunk and base of case original, but the hood is a poor quality replacement. Major crack to front panel of (new) hood. Slight warping to trunk door and small amount of cracking to trunk at top adjacent to top of door. Also with a pair of week going weights.
