### Condition Report

1460. (part of lot only inspected)

Blue printed nursery plate 'Poor Richard's Maxim's' - heavily crazed and stained, very minor glaze rubbing to rim.

Black printed nursery plate 'The Old Shoe' - heavily crazed with light staining.

Puce printed alphabet nursery plate - heavily crazed with staining, vertical haircrack at 6/o'clock, 4cm long.

Sunderland lustre compass mug - heavily crazed and stained, two vertical cracks to body, each around 6.5cm long. Light wear.
