A large early 20th century Neoclassical Revival mahogany extending dining table, the moulded top with five extra leaves above a fluted and gadrooned frieze, raised on fluted block legs, height 73cm, extended length 365cm, depth 137cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

2055. Generally condition is fairly good, the top having some overall surface scratches, particularly to the two ends. The ends and leaves are a consistent colour and the winding mechanism works well and is solid when fully extended. The areas of the table where there is a frieze fitted leaves it a bit tight for knee room, so could possibly have had castors originally. Otherwise some areas of beading on the legs damaged or missing.
