A large pair of Meissen porcelain magpies, late 19th/early 20th century, each modelled after Kaendler, perched on a tree stump with tail erect, underglaze blue crossed swords and impressed marks to bases, heights 52cm and 53.5cm (both beaks restored).

1437. Both with typical losses to the applied foliage and some minor glaze nicks to the base edges. Both with faults, repairs and some losses to the beaks and one tongue. Otherwise overall in good condition.
