A Bow porcelain figure of Winter, circa 1760-76, modelled as a seated man wearing a hooded jacket warming his hands over a brazier, raised on a rococo scroll base, painted anchor and dagger mark to base, height 16.5cm, together a Derby porcelain figure of a huntsman, circa 1770, with gun and dog by his side, 'Margaret Cadman Antiques' applied paper label to base, height 18.5cm (restored). Note: Christie's South Kensington sold the Margaret Cadman Collection of British Ceramics, 11th October 2002.

Condition Report

1426. Bow Figure - couple of tiny losses to applied foliage. Brazier missing one handle, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs.

Derby Figure - restoration to left hand, bird in this hand, right hand, small area to brim of hat, dog's right ear and head of pheasant on base. Missing bocage and with losses to remaining bocage with other small losses/chips overall. Crazeing to glaze.
