### LOT 1455

A pair of Royal Worcester blush ivory two-handled vases and covers, circa 1909, the ovoid bodies painted by W. Hale, signed, with opposing panels of gilded and enamelled flowers, within raised framing against a green shot relief moulded scale ground, flanked by mask moulded handles above the spreading circular feet, the covers with pseudo crown knobs, puce printed marks to bases with shape No. '2330', height 36cm (one repaired at top of foot).

### Condition Report

1455. 1st cover with glued knob and 1.5cm long narrow slice chip glued to underside rim edge. 2nd cover with 2cm by 1cm glued chip to rim edge.

1st vase with glued and re-gilded break to top of foot at base of vase and tiny chip of leaf beneath mask detail on one handle.

2nd vase in good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs.
