A Macintyre Florian Ware biscuit barrel with plated mounts and cover, 1898 to circa 1905, designed by William Moorcroft, the baluster body decorated in shades of blue with the Poppy pattern, the rim mounted with a swing handle, the plated cover with ring finial, brown printed and green painted marks to base, height to top of rim 14cm.

Condition Report

1448. Overall typical crazing to glaze with brown staining visible to the interior, 2 small glaze chips to edge of foot, widest part of body with losses and surface blemishes/abrasions to tubelining. Plated cover with 2 large areas of wear to surface, otherwise typical wear to mounts overall.
