A pair of Macintyre Moorcroft Aurelian Ware vases, circa 1904-13, the high shouldered tapered bodies decorated in Japan colours with opposing stylized flowers with gilded detail between scale and gilt panels enriched with iron red flowers, with trumpet necks and circular spreading feet, brown printed factory marks with blue printed Rd No and painted 'M432', height 31cm (restoration).

Condition Report

1453. Both with typical fine crazing to the glaze. 1st vase with glued break to top of foot which has minor glaze losses to the break line, otherwise in good condition. 2nd vase with two vertical haircracks opposite each other to neck which have been restored to the neck interior and break to foot which has been restored with spraying to foot exterior overall.
