Two Minton pottery Aesthetic teapots and covers, circa 1872, the first of gourd shape, relief moulded with leafy branches, butterflies and squirrels, the second moulded as joined bamboo poles flanked by prunus moulded panels, both with impressed marks to the base, second with shape No. '2268', each 13cm high (some restoration).

## Condition Report

1443. Squirrel Teapot - squirrel finial restored back into position on cover, typical overall fine crazing to main body with very light staining to interior.

Bamboo Teapot - 0.7cm long narrow chip to inside flange of cover, typical fine crazing to main body, professional restoration to end of spout and a few very minor glaze nicks to relief detail of handle.
