A Japanese mixed metal inlaid bronze vase, Meiji period, the ovoid body and flared neck finely decorated with peonies and prunus branch to one side and a bird flying over lotus to the other, incised mark to base, height 23.7cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1265. The vase is a bit dirty, but is in generally good order. No significant dents, bruises or repairs. Couple of very minor shallow dents. No apparent inlay loss. Typical light surface scratches and a little over-cleaned at some point. The black marks on the silver decoration is tarnish, but on the large flowers there are some small areas where the silver plate has worn through to the bronze behind.
