A Japanese Satsuma earthenware table oil lamp base, Meiji period, of swollen cylindrical form, painted and gilt with variously shaped panels filled with red capped cranes and flowers, gilt signatures within panels, height 36cm (cracked), with gilt metal fittings, detailed 'Hinks Duplex Patent', and glass chimney.

## Condition Report

1104. 13cm vertical crack from rim which joins a horizontal crack which is approx 17cm long and there are numerous hairlines running up into the body from the footrim. These hairlines range from 1cm long to 4cm in length. Otherwise typical light wear to gilt and enamels.
