## LOT 502

A gold, amethyst and half-pearl set oval pendant, circa 1910, claw set with the oval cut amethyst within a surround of half-pearls, with a gold neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '9c', length 40.5cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

## Condition Report

502. The central amethyst has one or two minor surface nicks. It is of medium colour saturation with very slight zoning. The surrounding half-pearls are in good condition. The original suspension loop may have been set with half-pearls, these are now lacking. The piece is apparently unmarked. The pendant would benefit from careful professional cleaning.

2.3cm high excluding loop surmount, 2.1cm wide, 1cm depth.

Pendant ◆ weight 7.4g.

Chain ◆ 1.3g.
