A gold, diamond and star ruby cluster bar brooch, mounted with the cabochon star ruby within a surround of eleven cushion shaped diamonds and one replacement colourless gem, each bar terminal with a diamond set five pointed star motif, mounted with the central cushion shaped diamond within a surround of five rose cut diamonds, width 4.5cm, total diamond weight approx 1.70ct, cabochon ruby weight approx 5.50ct.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

666. Cut: cabochon cut star ruby, the diamonds are old European cut. The fluorescence of the stones is faint. Colour: the ruby is a light red, diamonds approx F-G. Clarity: diamonds approx SI1-SI2. The star ruby has attractive asterism but there are a few surface marks. The surrounding diamonds are attractive well matched stones apart from one circular cut replacement colourless gem. The star motifs to the bar ends are in good condition. Suggested age - circa 1900. Weight 6.1g.
