A small group of glassware, 19th century and 20th century, including a St. Louis gilded decanter and stopper, a St. Louis three-piece garniture of ruby flashed campana shaped vases and two Mary Gregory style beakers.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1734. St. Louis Decanter - small bruise to top of stopper, the gilding overall is rubbed.

St Louis 3 piece garniture - in good condition overall, some very minor abrasions to facet edges of feet only noticeable on very close inspection. Rim interiors - particularly on largest vase - have surface wear/marks which don't seem to clean off.

Perfume bottle - light surface scratches and wear, generally ok.

Rummer - OK.

Mary Gregory tumblers x 2 - minor spot of gilding loss to rim of one, otherwise ok.

Duck by Waterford - ok

Paperweight - ok.
