Condition Report

1157. Generally in fairly good condition with some chips and minor losses to inlay but vast majority of inlay is present and intact. Some of the inlay appears to have been reglued/attached and some of the bond is apparent and visible. Lacquer ground has some staining from what looks like liquid spilt on it. Otherwise ok. Frame in good order with minor scuffs and chips.
