LOT 1261

A large collection of Chinese blue and white porcelain, 18th and 19th century, including export porcelain plates, dishes, meat plate and various vases, some with covers (faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1261. Overall most pieces have condition issues, whether that is cracks, chips, repairs or losses.
Pair of rouleau vases - both have, chips, cracks and repairs to rims, but are otherwise ok. 30cm high.
Large baluster vase & cover - cracks through body, otherwise ok. 36cm high.
A few of the small vases are in good condition, but most have either small chips, cracks or some restoration.
Smaller vases 13.5cm high.
Lotus painted vase (22cm high) - crack to rim.
Most lids have either chips or repairs.
Meat dish - large chip to rim, otherwise ok, length 40.5cm.
Large circular dish - cracked and rivet repaired. 34.5cm diameter.
Smaller circular dish - 4.5cm hairline to rim, otherwise good.
All plates and soup plates are either chipped, cracked or both, some repaired.
