LOT 1449

A large Moorcroft pottery Florian Ware circular bowl, dated 1918, the flared sides with upright rim, the interior with leaves and flowers in shades of blue, yellow and green, the exterior sides with indistinct vertical parallel lines, impressed Burslem factory mark to base with green painted signature and date, diameter 35.7cm.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

1449. Typical overall crazing to glaze. Short firing crack to rim which leads into minor hairline amongst the crazing. Some glaze flaws to exterior sides - a manufacturing issue. Indistinct haircrack visible to interior and exterior and running between two smaller manufacturing flaws to exterior - this runs around approximately half of bowl interior above well. Some paler green marking to glaze of well interior which have been there since manufacture, but do stand out a little. The bowl overall has a 'seconds' feel about it.
