A group of six Chinese export porcelain spoon trays, Qianlong period, four of lobed diamond shape, one of hexafoil form and one of lobed hexagonal form, all but one painted with figural scenes, lengths approx 13cm (one repaired and minor faults).

Condition Report

1194. Lobed Hexagonal Tray - Good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs. Typical light surface wear to gilt, enamels and glaze. Couple of tiny glaze scuffs to rim.

Underglaze Blue Lobed Hexagonal Tray - Good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs.

3 x Figural Diamond Shaped Trays - Good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs. Typical light wear to gilt and enamels. Minor glaze fritting to one (mandarin palette).

Floral Tray - Badly broken and repaired.
