A Mason's Patent Ironstone hydra jug, circa 1830, the octagonal body typically decorated in Imari colours with serpent handle, blue printed rounded crown mark to base, height 24.5cm, together with a sprigged grey stoneware jug, impressed 'Oriental' to base, and a similar brown stoneware jug (faults).

Condition Report

1537. 'Oriental' jug - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Missing tip of one sprigged leaf on neck - only noticeable on close inspection. Small vertical firing crack to shoulders of jug beneath spout, and similar to spout where mould lines join.
