A Chinese Ming style blue and white porcelain bottle vase, Qing dynasty, the body painted with a design of lotus flowers and scrolling leafy tendrils beneath a ruyi head collar, the waisted neck with a band of overlapping plantain leaves beneath bands of scrolls and ruyi heads, unmarked, height 36.5cm (repaired neck and section of rim missing).

Estimate: £1,000 - £2,000

Condition Report

1305. 6cm x 8cm section of the rim broken out and re-glued. Next to this there is a 1.5cm x 3cm section missing to rim. Numerous small chips/fritting to glaze on rim. Rest of the body is in good condition with typically light surface scratches to glaze. The base has an arch shaped firing crack to underside but this is in the manufacture not subsequent damage.
