A small group of Chinese porcelain, Qianlong period and later, comprising two export tea bowls (one repaired), a blue and white saucer and a blue and white double gourd vase, height 13.1cm, together with a Japanese Imari rice bowl and cover/stand, Meiji period, painted with a maple tree, diameter 11.3cm (chip to footrim).

Condition Report

1155. Famille rose tea bowl - section of rim broken out and rivet repaired.

Lobed tea bowl - good condition, few very minor rim chips.

Blue and white vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Minor wear to gilt.

Imari bowl and cover - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Minor surface scratches and wear to gilt on rims.
