A Chinese Canton famille rose enameled export porcelain urn and cover, early 19th century, the body moulded in relief with opposing gilt ovals enclosing figural scenes, within borders of further figures out of doors, moulded in relief with iron red and gilt bellflower swags beneath a pair of iron red and gilt pistol handles, on a circular foot and square base, the domed cover with weeping widow figural finial, height 41cm (restoration).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1030. Small area of professional restoration to rim edge of cover and professional restoration to figural finial of cover. Both handles professionally restored and restored break to centre stem of foot. Otherwise gilding and enamels remain strong and bright with minor wear.
