A Raynaud & Co 'La Fayette' pattern Limoges porcelain part dinner service, comprising ten dinner plates, ten dessert plates, five salad plates, three dessert bowls, four tureens and covers, three sauce boats with integral stands, an oval serving dish, twenty-one soup bowls and stands, eight teacups, fourteen coffee cups, eleven saucers, eight butter dishes, two teapots and covers, a coffee pot, three jugs and a sucrier and cover (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1534. Oval Serving Dish - large chip to foot rim.

Sauce Boat - one with chip to spout.

Teapots - both with chips to lid and spout.

Dinner Plates - two have chips to rim, all have some gilding wear and surface scratches.

Salad Plates - one hairline cracked, another chipped to rim.

Two Tureens with chips to rim, one tureen cover with glued handle.

One Teacup chipped.

Sucrier and cover - cover is chipped.

Coffee Pot - lacking cover and chip to spout.

One saucer with rim crack.

One butter dish chipped.

All other pieces in good condition with some gilding wear to rim of plates mostly.
