A pair of Chinese silk embroidered rectangular panels, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured and gilt threads with a pavilion and garden setting, 22cm x 14.5cm, mounted on the covers of a leather bound desk blotter, together with four Chinese silk embroidered sleeve panels, three framed and glazed.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1311. Blotter - one side missing glass and consequently this side with minor tear and staining to background paper. Glazed side with trapped dirt. Typical scuffs and wear to leather corners and edges, and spine quite cracked and scuffed. Interior tired and stained and missing ribbon.

3 framed and glazed panels - generally in good condition, typical light fading to colours and very minor staining.

Unframed panel - little faded as to be expected, minor thread loss.

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
